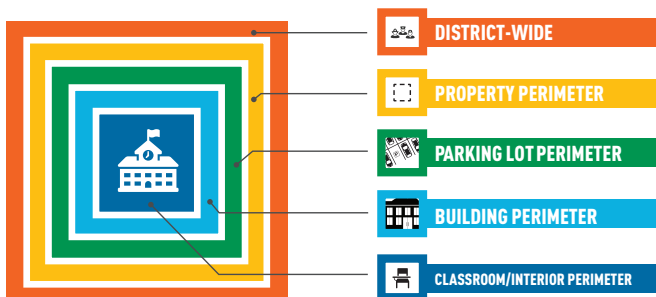

## Guidelines

These are the guidelines schools can use to create a comprehensive safety plan and technology road map. The primary focus areas are physical security and life safety infrastructure, essential elements of any comprehensive safety strategy. Layered Security combines components within each layer that effectively deter, detect and delay adversarial behaviors. Layered security works from the outside in. As one layer is bypassed the next layer provides an additional layer of protection.



The Guidelines focus on 5 Layers of protection



Common to these layers are 7 protective components

- Policies and Procedures
- People (Roles and Training)
- Architectural
- Communication
- Access Control
- Video Surveillance
- Detection and Alarms

For each component, the Guidelines provide options of four Tiers, from basic level (Tier 1) to the most sophisticated level (Tier 4).
